Your online profile shows you have a Master's degree in advertising and public relations along with a Bachelor's degree in engineering. I believe you will instantly understand the concerns we are communicating.

Water Wells First is a grassroots organization of water well owners in Chatham-Kent Ontario dedicated to the preservation of the 12,000 year old aquifer they depend on for their water supply will file complaints against AECOM a consultant engineering firm retained by the North Kent 1 windfarm in which Samsung Renewable Energy holds a 50% ownership with the Society of Professional Engineers of Ontario this week.

Letters of concern and complaint about this consultant acting on behalf of Samsung's financial interests have already been filed with Premier Wynne, MOECC Minister Glen Murray and REA Director Keyvanni as well as other MOECC management staff.

Please contact me at your earliest convenience so that we may arrange a conversation to discuss in detail what Samsung Canada can do to help Canadians protect their groundwater resources.

Our position is to ask you help us stop the construction of the North Kent 1 windfarm because the foundation construction for the 3.2 MW wind turbines would cause the degradation of groundwater quality and the loss of this source water supply to local families and place them at health and financial risks.
